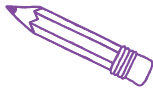

Book title: ON THE MOVE

On the Move is an interactive board book that explores different kinds of transport. Look at the car, spot a busy train and zoom to the moon on a rocket ship! This book has tabs to pull that add more and more to the story. Filled with new words and interesting pictures for your baby to look at, makes this book a perfect story to share.



Activity: Exploring shapes, sounds and movement

You will need:

- Template
- Scissors
- Glue
- Cardboard.

Instructions:

1. Cut out the black and white images
2. For young babies, lay down the cards in front of them during tummy time. Talk with your baby about the shapes you can see, point out the stars, the crescent moon and sing songs that have gentle actions such as *Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star*
3. For older babies glue or tape the black and white images onto heavier card. Show the images to your baby, let them hold and play with the cards. As your baby grows sing songs such as *Zoom, Zoom, Zoom We're Going to the Moon* – they will love interacting with you. To here this song visit: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=VhyY7TVApRI>

Ideas

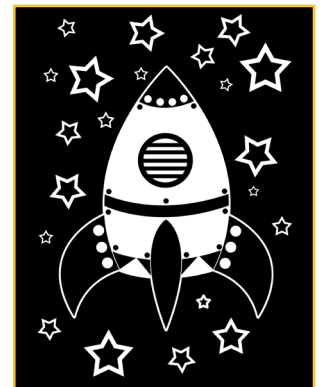

Some songs that explore sounds and movement include, *The Grand Old Duke of York*, *The Wheels on the Bus* or *Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear Turn Around*.
