

### What's the time?

Make a colourful watch and introduce your child to telling the time.



### Adult supervision is essential when making and playing with home made toys.

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible while creating this activity.

## WRISTWATCH

### You will need:

- copy of activity templates
- crayons, paint, pencils for decorating
- stickers, glitter, etc. for extra decoration.
- scissors
- tape

### Instructions

1. Decorate the watch. Help your child to draw the hands onto the watch at whatever time they wish.
2. Cut out the watch.
3. Wrap the watch around your child's wrist and tape straps together to fit.

### Ideas

Help your child to make the watch as a present for Mum or Dad.

Talk to your child about what time they wake up, have lunch, go to playgroup, go to bed, etc.

Show your child a clock and point out the numbers. If your clock doesn't have numbers on it, make some paper numbers and tape them onto the clock face.

Print the watch onto thicker paper to make it more robust.
