

## FLIP-AROUNDS

**Brrooom brrooom. What's hiding behind the big pile of sand?**

Make this simple 'flip-around' activity and watch your young one smile.



**Adult supervision is essential when making and playing with home made toys.**

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible while creating this activity.

**You will need:**

- copy of activity templates
- crayons, paint, pencils for decorating
- scissors
- glue
- 3 paddlepop sticks

### Instructions

1. Colour in the various images and cut them out.
2. There are 3 sets of flip-arounds. Tape a paddlepop stick to the back of one of the images of each set. Now glue each set together back-to-back.
3. Talk to your child and ask questions like, 'What could be behind the pile of sand?' Flip the sand pile around to reveal the digger. Repeat with the other 2 sets.

### Idea

This could also be used as a simple matching game. Colour in and cut out the images and show your child which sets go together. Talk to your child the whole time and tell them what you're doing. Say things like, 'Here's a plane, zoom zoom. Planes can fly through the clouds. Look here is a cloud, this must belong with the plane.'
