

Fox in the Bush

Watch as the fox creeps out of the bush.



Adult supervision essential

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible.

*WARNING

Craft knives must only be used by an adult. The blade must be retracted when not in use. Do not let your child play with the knife.

SLIDING FOX

You will need:

- a copy of each template
- scissors
- textas/coloured pencils
- thin card (approx. 2 x A4)
- glue
- stapler
- craft knife

Instructions

1. Colour Fox and Bush.
2. Glue both shapes onto thin card. Cut out when dry.
3. Using craft knife cut along line around bushes (not bottom line)
4. Fold back bottom strip of bush (along line) to act as gutter for Fox to slide in. Staple ends to close gutter.
5. Place Fox in gutter, behind the bush.
6. Thread tab near nose through slit.

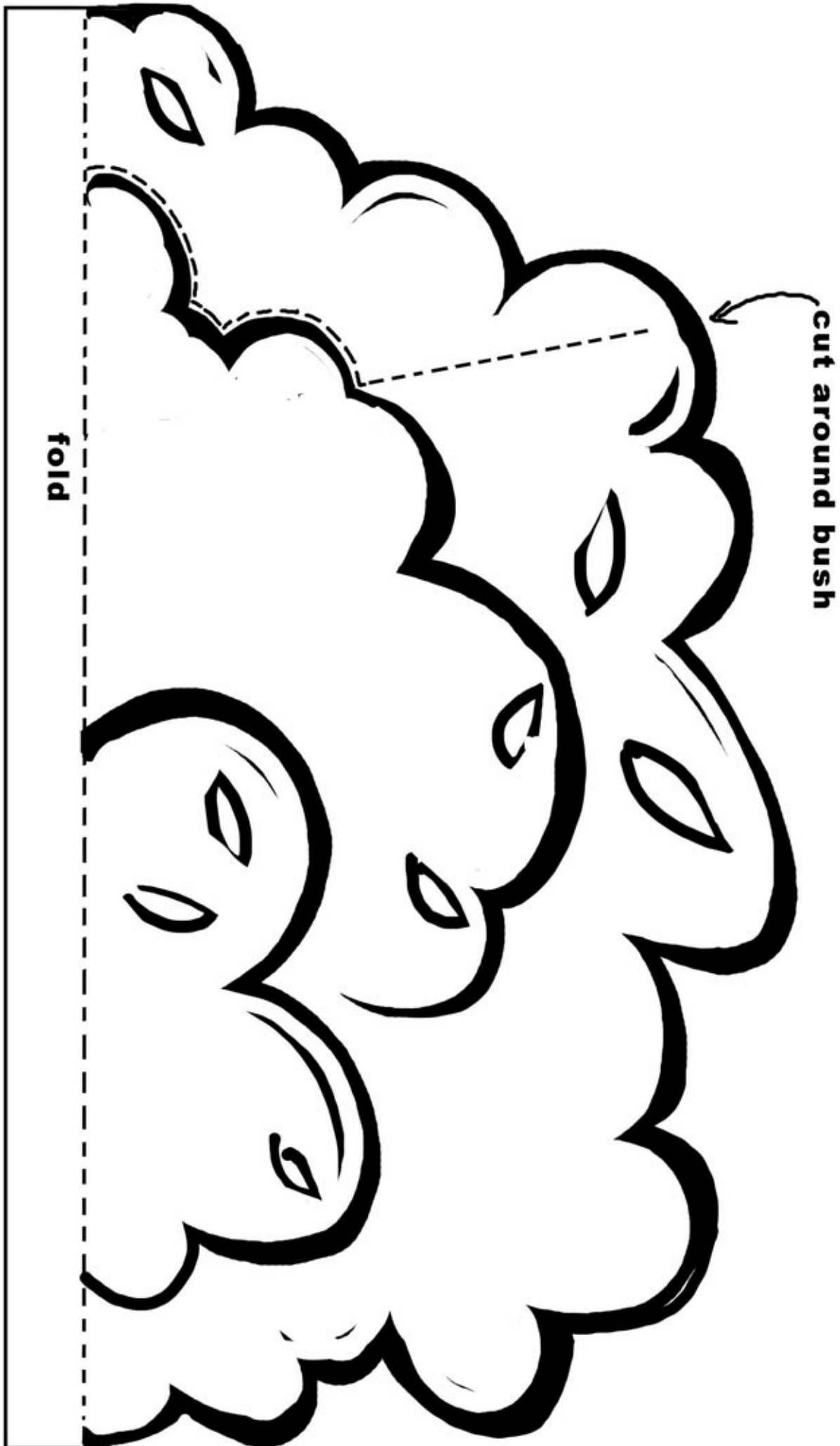
Now slowly slide Fox in and out of the bush.

Ask questions such as "Can you see a nose?"

"I can see two eyes. Can you?"

Use the Sliding Fox while you read the story.

Tell the story using the Sliding Fox and the Paper Plate Chicken from the other activity.
