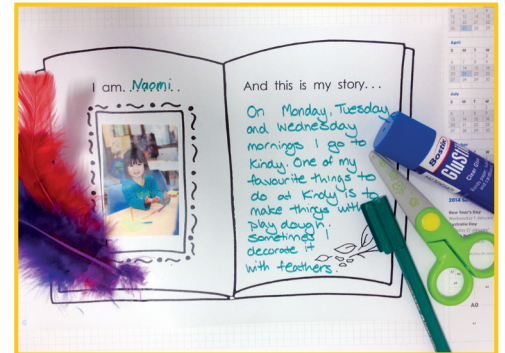




Theme: Connect to reading

Put your story on a page

You will need:

- Photos or drawings of yourself, your family or your home
- Scissors, glue
- Pencils, textas, etc
- Template (optional)

**Adult supervision is essential.
Involve and talk with your child
as much as possible.**

Method

1. Cut out a picture of yourself stick to paper/template
2. Have your family member or friend help you write or draw your own story using words, pictures or photos.

Ideas:

The story can be

- what you did today
- what you would like to do today e.g a visit to the playground or park
- a past adventure (add any collected treasures e.g. leaves, gumnuts, pebbles).

Have fun sharing aloud your story to your best friends... teddy, duck, bear or kanga and maybe your family too.

Visit your local library, borrow books and have fun at a story time session.

Read other books: *The Children Who Loved Books* by Peter Carnavas, *Parsley Rabbit's Book About Books* by Frances Watts and David Legge

Key Message: Children learn through being engaged and doing.

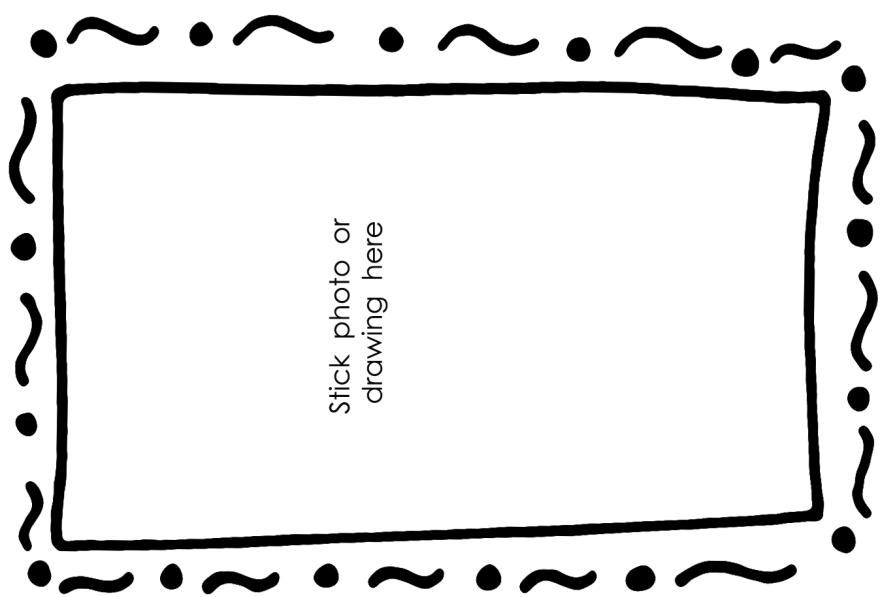
