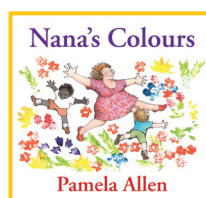




## Theme: Colours

## Our favourite colours poster

### You will need:

- Template
- Textas
- Paints, pencils or glitter (optional).

### Instructions:

1. Chat with your child about different colours and which ones they like.
2. Ask a few family members or friends what their favourite colours are.
3. Spend some time writing each person's name and favourite colours on the template.
4. Decorate the template if desired with paints, or colouring in.
5. Pin it up and talk about the colours.

### Ideas:

Use different coloured chalks to draw shapes on the footpath outside. Jump in and out of each coloured shape (flowers or leaves) and call out the colours and shapes.

Talk with your child about rainbows and all the different colours. Can you find different coloured objects around your home or garden and lay them out in a rainbow shape?

Can you eat a rainbow by eating different coloured foods over a day? What are your child's favourite red, yellow, green... coloured foods? For eg, red apples, yellow bananas, green peas.

### Key Message: Children are born ready to learn.
