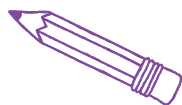

You will need:

- You and your baby.

Instructions:

- Make time to spend with your baby free from distractions
- Cuddle up with your baby, holding them close
- Share stories with your baby
- Talk with your baby, play games and sing songs.

Further information

When children feel safe and secure they are more confident to try new experiences. Create a nurturing environment by paying whole attention to your child. When you turn off distractions and spend one-on-one time with your baby you are helping them to understand they are special and this is when the best learning can happen.

Take time to talk with your baby about what you are doing, seeing or hearing during every day activities. The more words we use, the more words babies are hearing and this helps support their vocabulary development.

Hey Mum, I love you is a great book that has beautiful photographs of many different animals and lots of new words for your baby to hear. Sharing stories over and over is an activity that will help you to introduce your baby to new and exciting words. Cuddle up with your baby and enjoy exploring books together.
