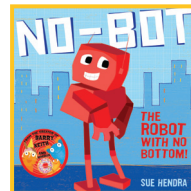




## Theme: Humour

## Shiny happy robots!

### You will need:

- Template
- Toilet rolls or cardboard
- Alfoil
- Pipecleaners
- Textas (permanent markers are best)
- Other decorations, such as stickers, if wanted.

**Adult supervision is essential.  
Involve and talk with your child  
as much as possible.**

### Instructions:

1. Colour and cut out template
2. Cover the toilet roll with alfoil, or cut a square of cardboard and cover with alfoil
3. Draw a face, and buttons, dials and lights
4. Stick on pipe cleaner arms and legs
5. Add more decorations if wanted.

### Ideas

Make different colour robots using wrapping paper or scrap paper from around the house.

Explain how robots are machines and talk about other machines around your home.

Try walking, talking and dancing like robots encouraging imaginative play.

Make a robot costume by using a cardboard box with arm holes cut out. Decorate it or paint it red like Nobot.

### Song

I'm a little rocket (to the tune of *I'm a little teapot*, or make up your own song).

### Key Message: Children learn from watching and copying.
