Book title: THE WORST PRINCESS

Make a colourful dragon

You will need:

- Scissors/glue
- Sheets of coloured paper
- Large piece of paper/card
- Templates.

**Adult supervision is essential.
Involve and talk with your child
as much as possible.**

Instructions:

1. Trace around your child's hand on each sheet of coloured paper (you need approx 10 hands)
2. Cut out hands and templates (your child will need your help with this)
3. Glue on to large piece of paper/card in shape of a dragon's body
4. Glue on the face and tail.

Ideas

Talk about dragons being mythical creatures. What are some other mythical creatures (unicorn, mermaids, etc) that exist in stories?

Talk about Princesses, Princes, Knights, Kings and Queens and medieval times.

Make a cubby house castle, use a chair or red cushion for a throne, and fill a cardboard box with treasures.

Make a dragon mask and pretend to be dragons encouraging imaginative play.

Go on a treasure hunt for gold chocolate coins.

Key Message: Children learn though being engaged and doing.
