

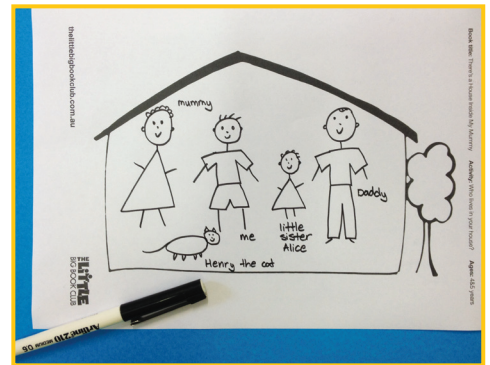
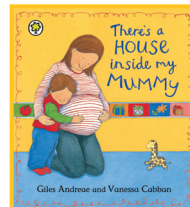


Theme: New Siblings

Who lives in your house?

You will need:

- Template
- Pencils, textas etc.

**Adult supervision is essential.
Involve and talk with your child as much as possible.**

Instructions:

1. Ask your child to draw who is in their family (using the house template)
2. Point to each person and ask your child to name the people in their drawing
3. Write the names of the people as you go.

Ideas

Talk with your child about their family. Are they a big/little brother/sister? Where do they fit into the family?

Talk about the extended family: cousins, aunts, uncles, grandparents.

Have a look at photos of your child and yourself when you were babies.

Make an album with drawings or photos of family and special people in your child's life.

Songs:

"Rock a bye baby".

Key Message: The best learning happens in nurturing relationships.
