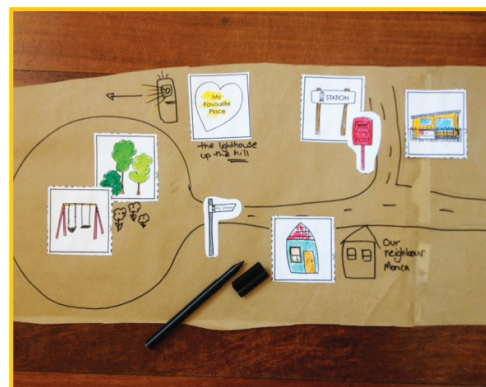
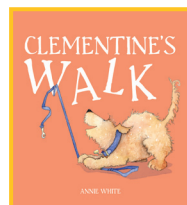




Theme: Getting out and about

Book title: CLEMENTINE'S WALK

Make a map of your local area!

You will need:

- Template (optional)
- Textas, pencils, stickers, etc
- Large sheets or a roll of paper
- Gluestick or sticky tape

**Adult supervision is essential.
Involve and talk with your child
as much as possible.**

Instructions:

1. Take a walk up and down your street/area to make a list of what you see
2. Roll out a long length of paper and draw your street/area
3. Colour/decorate the template and cut out the items
4. Stick the template items that you saw onto your street picture
5. Draw or paint anything that is missing from your street collage/mural.

Ideas:

Talk about some of the things you saw on your walk. Is there something that is always there (letterbox, tree, shop, fence) or is there something different today (roadworks, puddles)?

If you have a pet spend some time talking about it. Explain what type of animal it is and give details about its colour, shape, size, feel, age, and what your pet likes to eat and do. Look at books for other animals and pets you can talk about.
