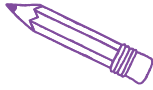

I spy

You will need:

- You and your baby.

What to do:

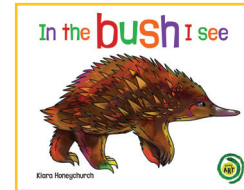
1. Sit out in a garden or local park with your baby.
2. Talk with your baby about the different sounds of birds, insects or animals that you can hear.
3. You can ask questions like “Can you hear the magpie singing loudly?” and wait for a moment. Your baby may coo, babble or look around.
4. Then give the answer “Yes I hear it singing it too.” This is how your baby starts to learn words and how conversations work.
