

MAKE FACES
My face, your face.

Use this activity to make your face and your child's face. You can even add bodies if you like.


Adult supervision is essential when making and playing with home made toys.

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible while creating this activity.

You will need:

- copy of activity template
- crayons, paint, textas, pencils for decorating
- tape
- scissors

Instructions

1. Help your child to draw your face and their face on the blank templates. Talk to them about what features their face has. eg; brown eyes, straight hair, big smile.
2. Choose 2 bodies, colour them in and cut them out. Cut out the faces you have already drawn and tape them to the bodies.

For the very young

Do Step 1 only. Talk to your child while you draw their face onto the blank template. Say things like 'Your eyes are green, let's find a green pencil to draw them with'. Point to the faces and say 'There's you and there's me'.

Idea

Use the body templates and add photos of faces of family and special friends. Make this into a special book to share with your child.
