

### What's inside the box?

Make a paper plate box to hide pictures inside. Open the box, 'Peekaboo! What can you see?'



**Adult supervision is essential when making and playing with home made toys.**

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible while creating this activity.

## PAPER PLATE PEEKABOO

### You will need:

- copy of activity template
- crayons, paint, textas, pencils for decorating
- 2 paper plates (small)
- scissors
- tape
- pipecleaner

### Instructions

1. Colour in the four pictures and cut out.
2. Tape the two paper plates together with a piece of tape. This forms the hinge of the paper plate box. Now make a loop out of a small piece of pipecleaner and tape this to the front of the top plate. (see diagram)
3. Place one of the pictures on the bottom plate and close the other plate over the top. Ask your child something like 'What will we see inside?' Lift the top plate up to reveal the picture, 'Peekaboo! It's a beetle'.
4. Now place a different picture inside and repeat the peekaboo game.

### Ideas

If your child is able, let them choose a picture to place inside the plates. Now the adult has to guess what's inside.

Place photos of family members in the plates.

Decorate the outside of the paper plate box.

Colour in and cut out these pictures.  
Then place them one at a time inside  
the paper plate box.
