

**SOCK SIGNS**
**Socks to hang on your door.**

Make a cute name sign for your child's bedroom door.


**Adult supervision is essential when making and playing with home made toys.**

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible while creating this activity.

**You will need:**

- copy of activity template
- crayons, paint, textas, pencils for decorating
- 1 sock
- piece of ribbon or wool
- 1 peg
- scissors
- tape

**Instructions**

1. Choose either the rabbit or squirrel. Colour in the animal and cut out.
2. Write your child's name on the blank sign.
3. Tape the sign to the sock so the shoulders of the animal line up with the top of the sock.
4. Peg the sock to the piece of ribbon. Tape the ribbon onto your child's door.

**Ideas**

When you are doing the washing, encourage your toddler to help you match the pairs of socks.

Compare your socks to your child's socks. Talk about which ones are big and which ones are small. What other things can you find that are big and small.

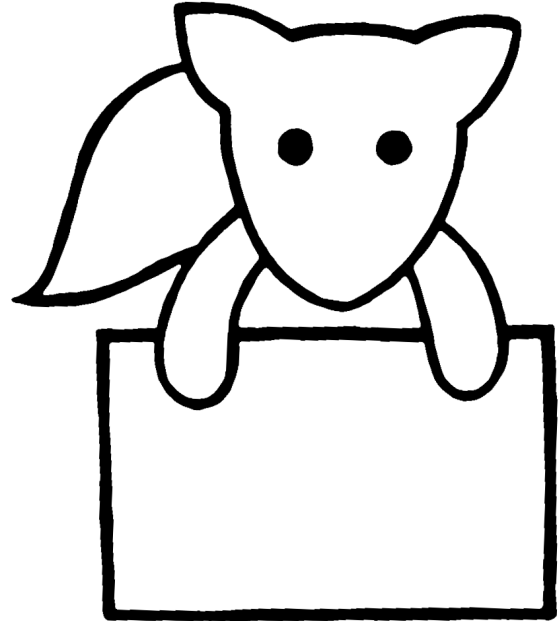
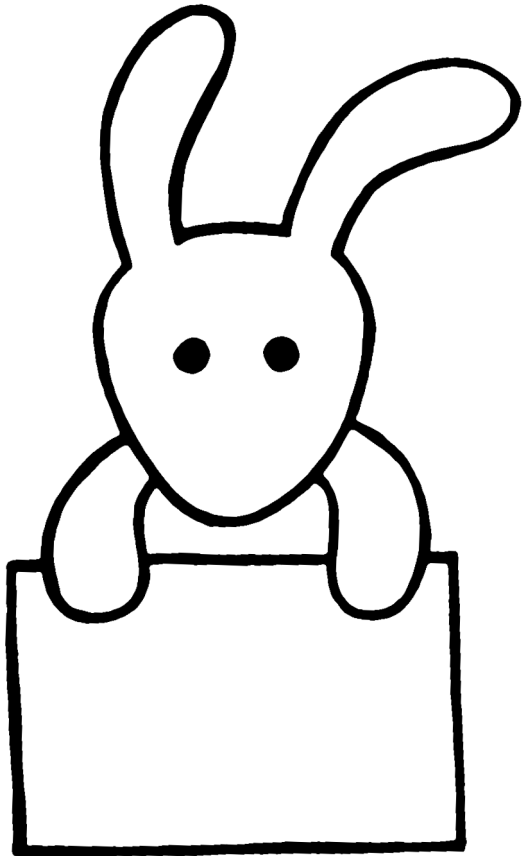
Use the templates to write little messages to your children, for example,

I love you because. . .

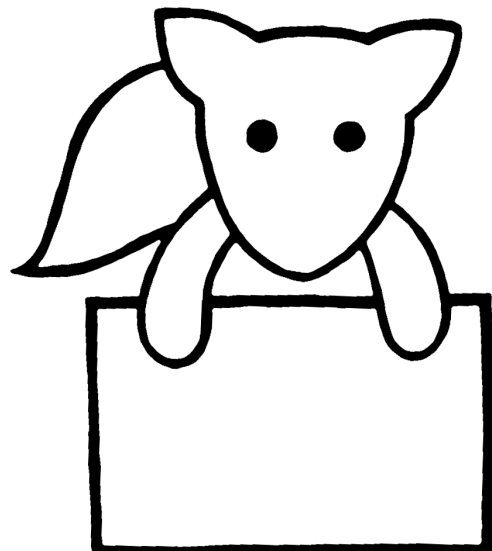
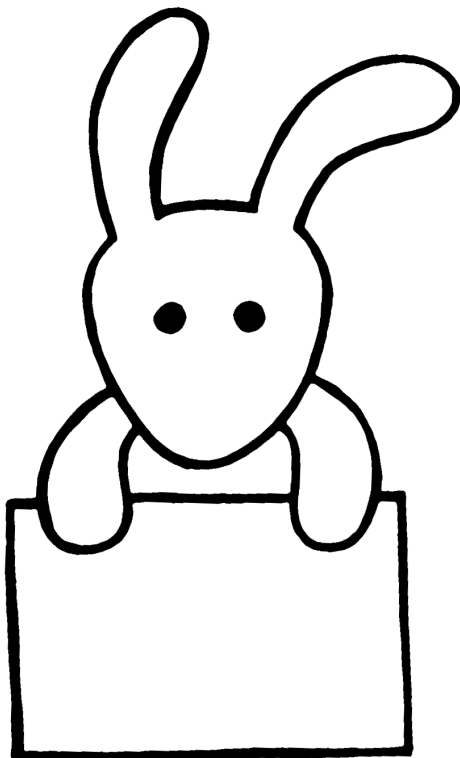
Thank you for . . .
