Where's Mrs Hen?

A perfect book to share with your baby to find the friendly farmyard animals hiding behind bright felt flaps. And there's a mirror on the final page!

Peek-a-boo face board

You will need:

- You and your baby
- Photo of your baby's face
- Glue and sticky tape
- Fabric or card
- Scissors.

What to do:

1. Glue/attach the photo of your baby's face onto the card
2. Cut another piece of card/fabric large enough to cover the photo
3. Sticky-tape the card/fabric into place to make a flap
4. Show your baby the card, and how to lift the flap to reveal your baby's face
5. Talk with your baby as you play this Peek-a-boo game together.

More ideas:

You can also play peek-a-boo with your baby sitting on your lap and looking into the mirror together. Gently cover your baby's eyes with your hands – quickly drop them and say "peek-a-boo" with a big smile on your face – your baby will love it.

Songs to sing

"Where's My Baby Peekaboo!" to the tune of *Skip To The Loo*, *Where Is Thumbkin*, and *Round and Round the Garden*.
