

MY FIRST BOOK

Baby's book of 'first things'.

Make a book to record your baby's first sounds, likes and marks.



Adult supervision is essential when making and playing with home made toys.

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible while creating this activity.

You will need:

- copy of activity templates
- crayons, paint, pencils for decorating
- scissors
- piece of coloured A4 paper, 140gsm or heavier
- gluestick

Instructions

1. Fold the piece of coloured A4 paper in half.
2. Cut out the different book pages. Glue the pages onto the coloured paper in page order.
3. Write your baby's details under the various headings. Page 4 is blank for you to put your baby's first hand and foot prints.
4. Decorate with stickers if you wish.

Ideas


Add more pages as your baby develops. Insert the new pages into the centre of the book (the coloured paper will become the cover). Bind all the pages together with a piece of wool.

You may like to stick a photo of your baby's face on the front cover (over the illustration).

Rather than making a book you could make a poster. Glue the 4 pages onto a piece of A3 paper (or larger). Stick the poster up in your baby's room. Maybe you could stick photos of you and your baby to the poster too.




