

## Make Piglet

Help your child to turn a tin can into a wiggly-tailed piglet



### Adult supervision essential

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible.

### You will need:

- an empty lidded tin, eg. a Milo tin
- 1/2 egg carton
- pink tissue paper
- white craft glue
- jar
- paint brush (approx 2-3 cm. wide)
- texta (brown – red)
- pink pipe cleaner
- 2 'wobbly eyes'
- scissors/craft knife
- masking tape
- pink felt/thin card
- photocopy of ear template

## PIGGY TIN

### Instructions

1. Make sure Milo tin is thoroughly clean. Place lid on tin.
2. Cut 5 'cups' from egg carton.
3. Tape one cup to the lid end of tin (nose).
4. Tape four cups to side of tin (legs). (see photo)
5. In jar, mix small amount of white glue with equal amount of water.
6. Tear small pieces of tissue paper and, using brush and glue mix, layer paper over the tin, 'legs' and 'nose' until covered (several layers).
7. Allow to dry.
8. Stick on tail (pipe cleaner) and eyes. Draw nostrils and mouth.
9. Trace ear shapes onto felt/card.
10. Cut out and glue on as in photo.

Allow your child to help as much as possible.  
 Talk with your child as you work together.
