3. Take your baby for a walk. Point and label trees, birds, clouds and items of interest.

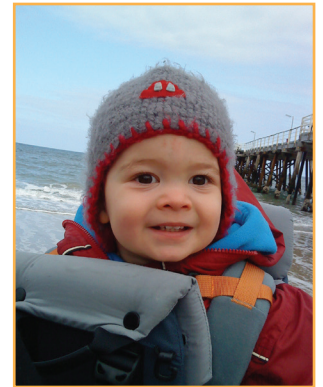
