

Create a dragon.

Help your child put together a colourful dragon picture from cut out paper pieces.



Adult supervision is essential when making and playing with home made toys.

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible while creating this activity.

DRAGON PICTURE

You will need:

- copy of activity template
- paint, crayons, textas, etc.
- piece of coloured A4 paper
- scissors
- gluestick
- tracing paper (or: cellophane, baking paper)
- black texta

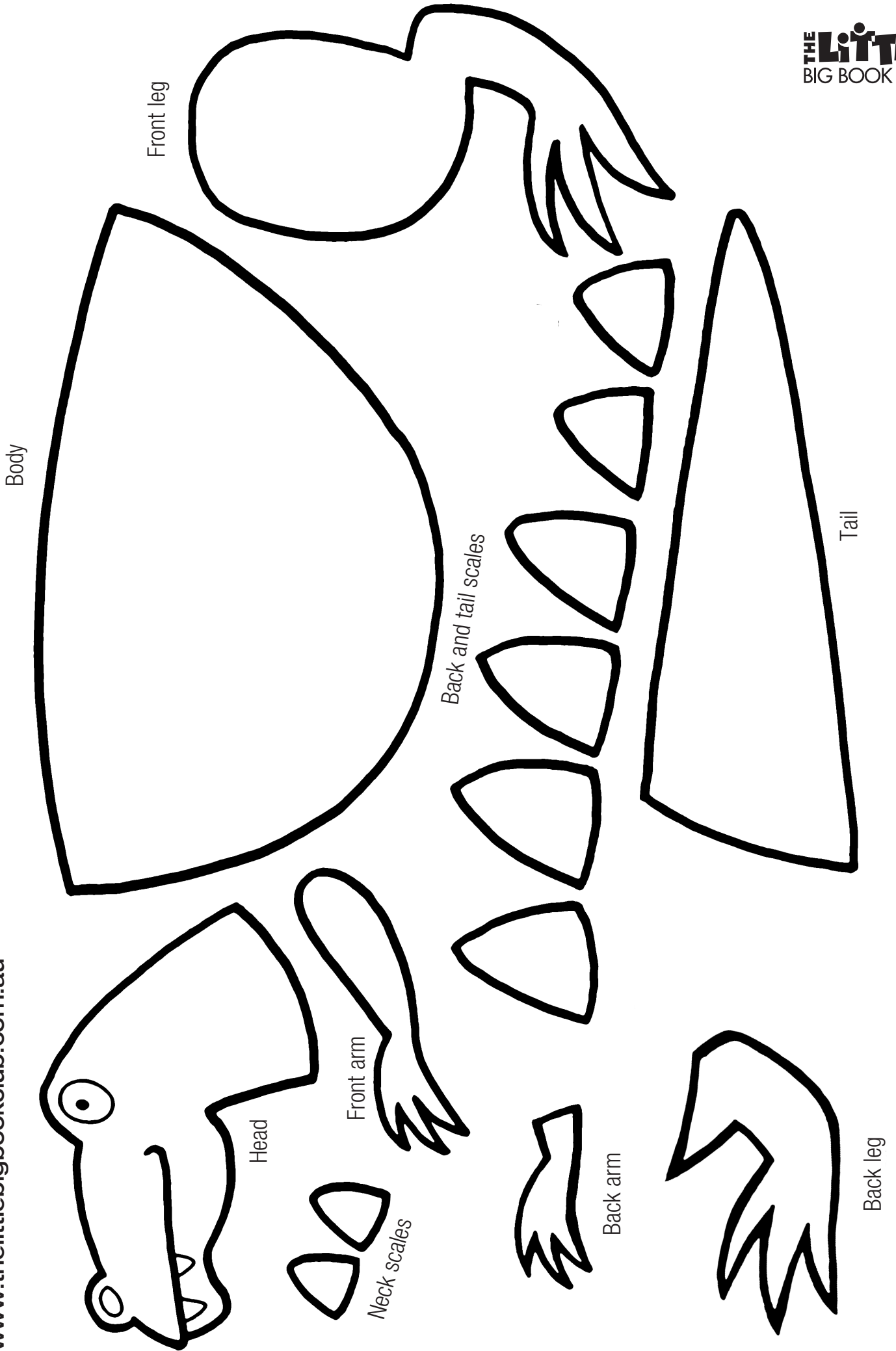
Instructions

1. Colour in all the different dragon pieces and cut out.
2. Using the guide provided, help your child to glue all the pieces onto the sheet of A4 paper. Start with the 'body' piece first and then add the head, tail and other pieces.
3. Trace the wing shape onto a piece of tracing paper and cut out. Glue in place on the dragon's back. Use a black texta to outline the wing.

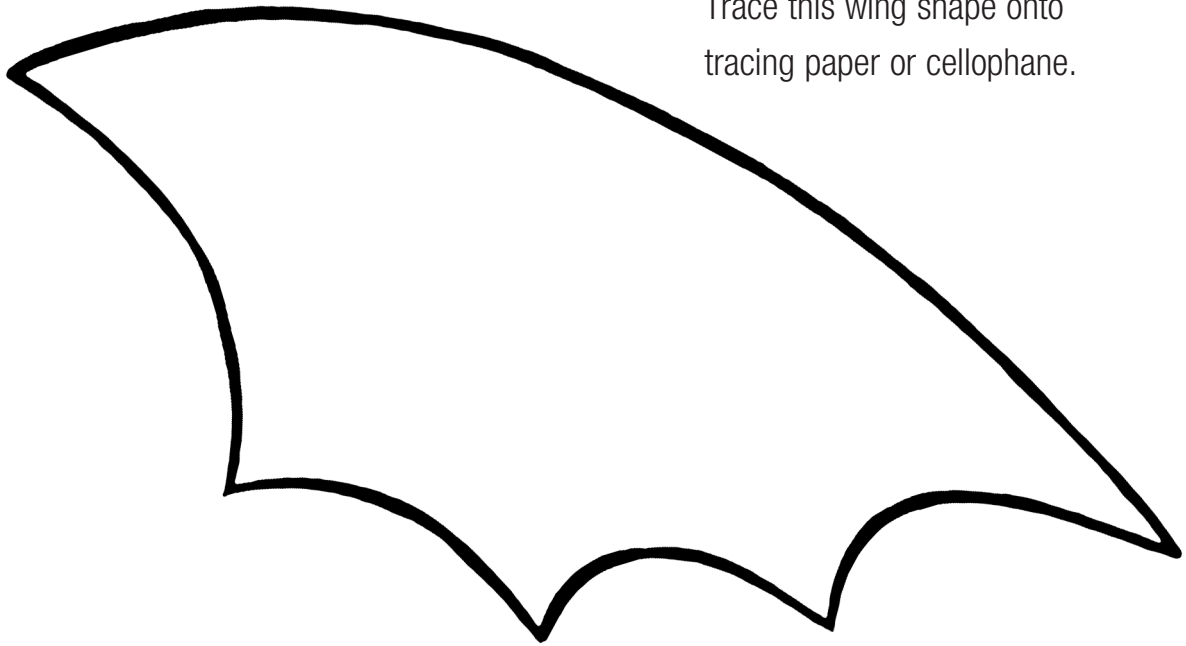
Ideas

You could decorate your picture further by cutting different sized spots out of coloured paper and gluing them onto the dragon. You could also add glitter to make the dragon shimmer.

If you glue the dragon to a piece of paper larger than A4, you could draw flames coming out of its mouth.



Trace this wing shape onto tracing paper or cellophane.



Use this diagram as a guide for putting the dragon together.
