

**Grandpa's Pens (or Grandma's)**  
 Make a container for Grandpa to store his pens in.



### Adult supervision essential

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible.

## PEN CONTAINER

### You will need:

- 1 litre milk carton
- photocopied templates
- coloured pencils/textas
- scissors/craft knife
- A4 sheet coloured paper
- glue
- tape
- cottonwool/wool/wire (as required)

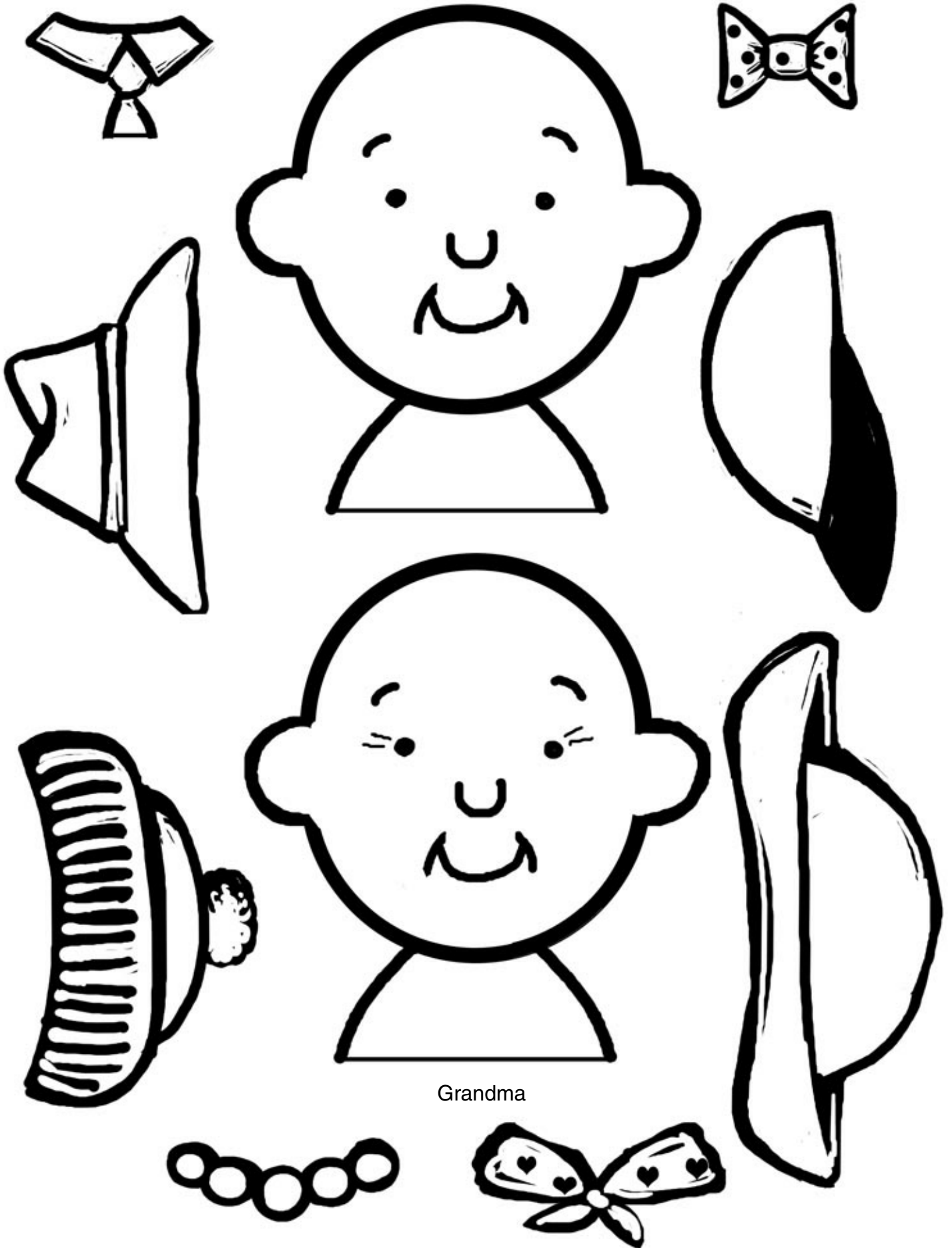
### Instructions

1. Cut carton down to height of 110 mm.
2. Cut 110mm x 297mm strip of coloured paper.
3. Glue reverse side of strip and cover milk carton with it.
4. Colour in Grandpa (or Grandma).
5. Cut out and glue onto covered carton.
6. Add hair (eyebrows, moustache etc. as desired) using wool/cottonwool.
7. Add glasses (make from wire or draw on with texta) and other features, as desired.

Talk to your child about what Grandpa looks like while doing the activity.

Discuss how you can make the face look like Grandpa's.
