

**Kids in a wheelbarrow!**

Help your child complete this wheelbarrow picture.

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible while creating this activity.

- glue

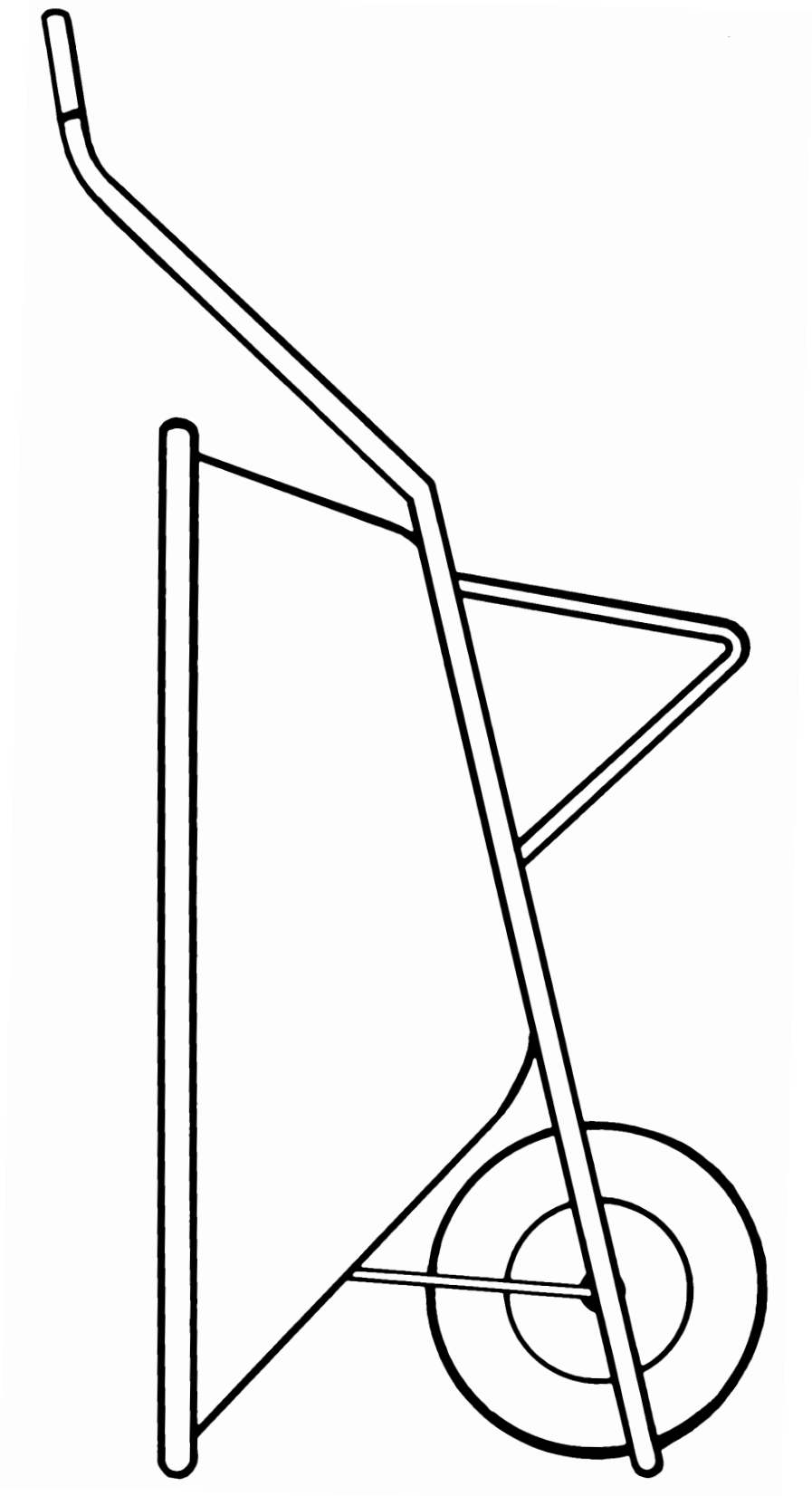
**Instructions**

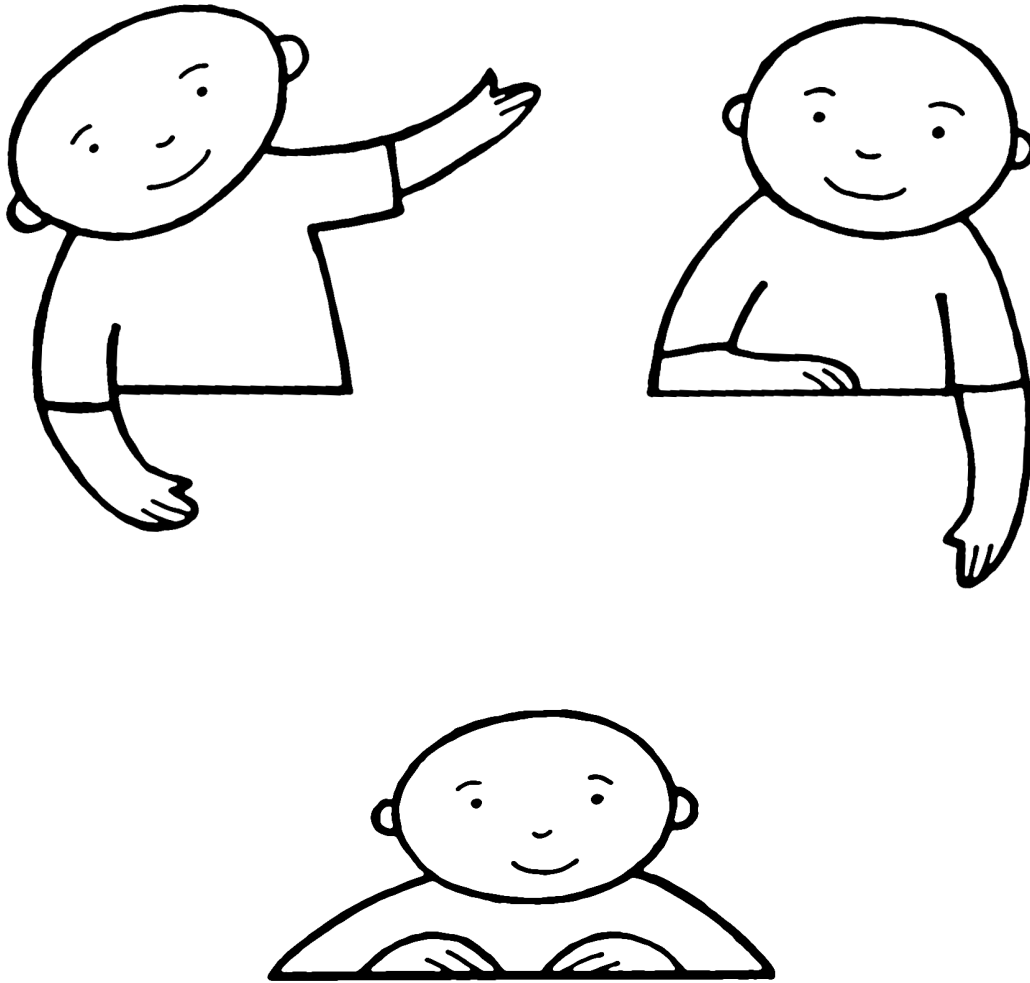
1. Colour in the wheelbarrow.
2. Encourage your child to draw themselves and a sibling (or friend) in the wheelbarrow. They may even like to draw a pet as well. Alternatively colour in and cut out the children and pet templates provided. Draw hair, hats or glasses onto the children.

**Ideas**

You could draw a background around the wheelbarrow. This could be a garden or maybe the wheelbarrow is flying through outer space or floating on the ocean!

If you have a wheelbarrow let your child climb in. Maybe even give them a ride!





Use these as an alternative to drawing children in the wheelbarrow. Colour these children in, add hair, hats, glasses, etc. Then cut them out and glue them into the wheelbarrow. You may even like to include some pets in your wheelbarrow.
