

Who's crossing over my bridge?

Help your child make the kangaroos and the troll and place them on the bridge.



Adult supervision is essential when making and playing with home made toys.

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible while creating this activity.

ON THE BRIDGE

You will need:

- copy of activity instructions
- textas, coloured pencils, etc.
- 4 paddlepop sticks
- thin cardboard (cereal box)
- scissors & craft knife
- tape
- blutak

Instructions

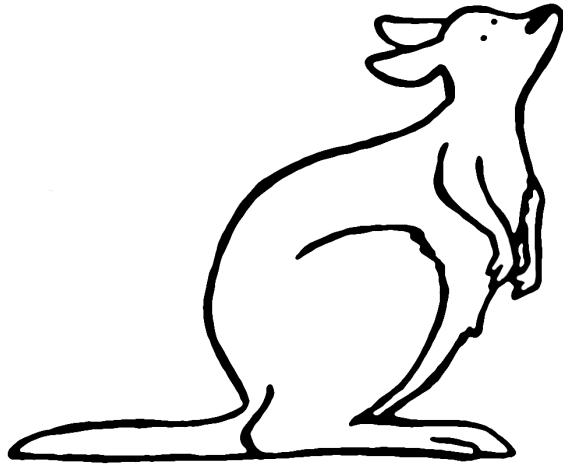
1. Colour in the kangaroos and the troll.
2. Tape a paddlepop stick to the back of each animal.
3. Cut a piece of cardboard 6cm x 30cm.
4. Using the diagram as a guide, mark where you are going to place each animal on the bridge.
5. Cut 4 slits into the cardboard with a craft knife*. Slot the animals into the slits.
6. Curve the cardboard to make the bridge shape and hold in place, on a hard surface, with blutak.

*Warning

Craft knives must only be used by an adult.

The blade must be retracted when not in use.

Do not let your child play with the knife.



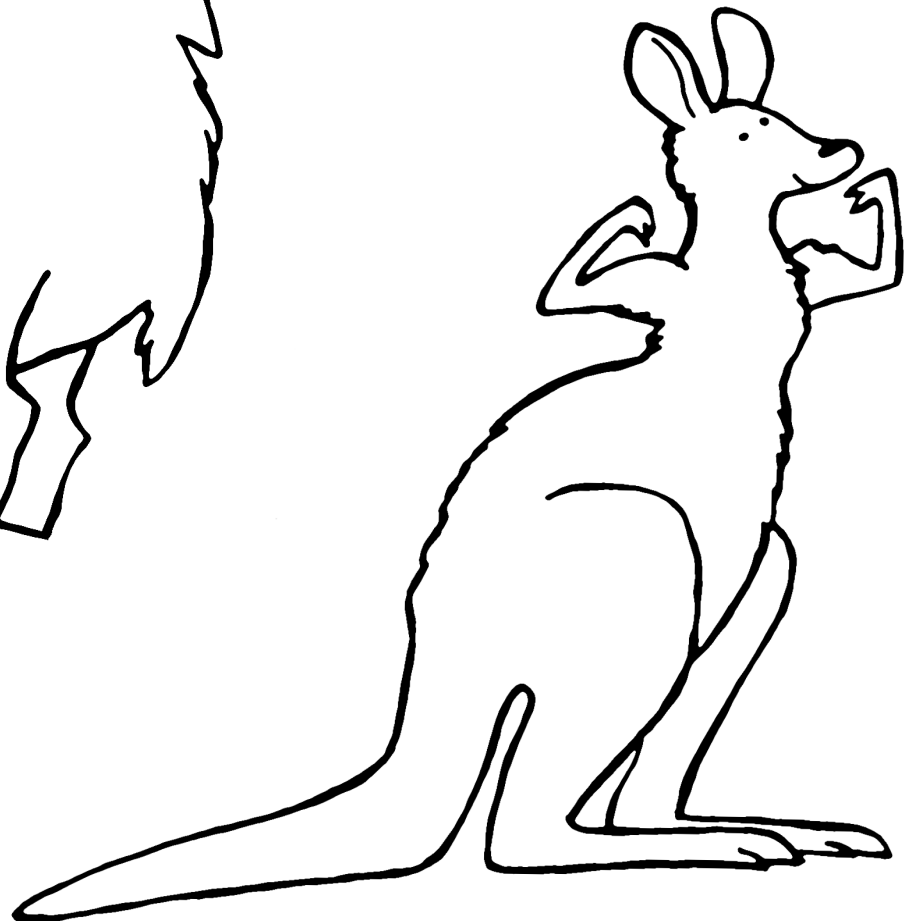
small kangaroo



medium kangaroo

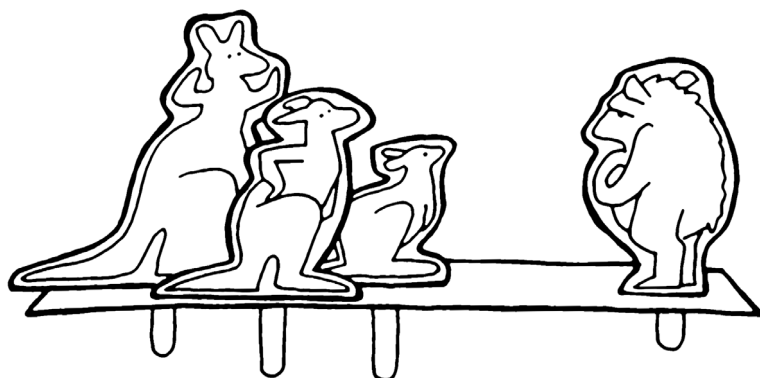


troll

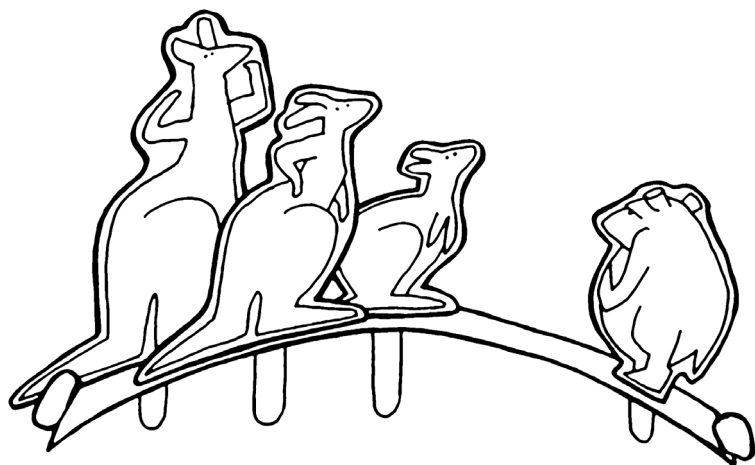


large kangaroo

Use the diagram to the right as a guide for where to place the animals on the bridge.



Mark the cardboard and carefully cut 4 slits with a craft knife. Slot the paddlepop sticks into the slits.



Curve the cardboard and hold in place on a hard surface with blutak.
