

**We're going on an adventure!**  
 Help your child trace the correct path from one house to the other.



**Adult supervision is essential when making and playing with home made toys.**

Involve and talk with your child as much as possible while creating this activity.

## FOLLOW THE PATH

### You will need:

- a copy of activity template
- crayons, textas, pencils, for decorating

### Instructions

1. Using a texta, ask your child to trace the path from the START house to the FINISH house.
2. Once completed you could ask questions like 'Can you see a ball? a dog? letterbox?'
3. Your child could colour in the map if they wish.

### Idea

Make an obstacle course for your child using things around the house like cushions, chairs, boxes, toys etc. Decide with your child what will be the correct path to take. eg; over the cushions, around the chair, under the dining table and find teddy at the end. You could even draw a map showing the way.
